

SECTION 6 - DJ REQUIREMENTS / EQUIPMENT

- 1 table approximately 3 feet x 8 feet with table skirting
- To be located near three (3) electrical outlets (2 different circuits if possible) dedicated to Dream Weaver Entertainment.
- To be located next to the dance floor.
- To be located under shelter if this is an outdoor event.

TIP - Importance Of The DJ Next To The Dance Floor - One of the most important factors in the success of your reception is where the DJ sound system is to be located. It is critical that the DJ system be placed in an area directly next to the dance floor. It is also important that the DJ have a good line of sight to the entrance of the room, head table, and cake table. As your Master of Ceremonies, we need to be able to see each of these areas in order to control the timing of each event. It is not recommended to surround your dance floor on all four sides with tables and place the DJ in the back corner. Remember our speakers need to carry sound to the dance floor area. If there are tables directly between the speakers and the dance floor, the guests seated at those tables will have an uncomfortable level of sound. Please be sure to provide us with a minimum of a 6' X 15' area to set our sound systems and light show.
